Adam & Eve and the Fall

Genesis 2:5-24 to 3:24 (Selected verses)

Major Segments:

- The creation of man in a brand new world.
- The trees in the garden
- The creation of woman from man's rib
- The snake tempts them to eat from forbidden tree
- Man and women eat from forbidden tree and are banned from garden

Segment Questions:

- What mental image comes to your mind of how God formed man? Consider some of the descriptive words that are used to describe how it happened.
- Why in the midst of a perfect world did God forbid them to eat from that one tree?
- How long do you think it took to name all the animals? What do you think that did to Adam's response to when he finally saw Eve?
- What do you think is meant by "This is the reason a man leaves his parents..." What's the reason and what's the connection to "become one flesh?"
- Describe the sequence that the snake (Satan) uses to cause the man and women to eat the forbidden fruit and to sin?
- What do you think happened to the "Tree of Life" and the Garden of Eden?
- **Bonus**: In the Garden, eating from the Tree of Life was a physical action that gave them life. Eternal life is now a "spiritual" action of putting our faith in Christ. How does that work? Did God change the rules? Did God "change?"

Action Questions:

- What are some things in your life where you feel you are most susceptible to the smooth talking temptations of Satan?
- Will we know good from evil in heaven and what are the implications of your opinion?
- Are there things in your life where you saw God take "dramatic action" in order to protect you from something much worse?

Imagine the earth when it was new before the plants had come up. In those days, God hadn't yet allowed it to rain on the earth, but caused a mist to come each day to water all the land. During this time, God took some soil and shaped the first man. He breathed into his nostrils, and Adam was alive.
