Financial Discipleship: Teaching Responsible Money Habits

Why is it hard to talk about financial issues with other Christians? In his decades of talking with pastors and ministry leaders, Ron has discovered three main reasons. 1) Perception of motive; 2) Diversity of needs and 3) A feeling of inferior knowledge.

What would happen if we had some simple tools that could be used to change the culture of financial understanding within our churches. In this session Ron will talk about the “why” of helping to build financial literacy in our Christian communities. He will share ideas for a model that can be used to help build a culture of change.
