Under his leadership and coaching, Indiana wrestlers have excelled in NCAA competition, with a focus on building program momentum and fostering a thriving wrestling community in Indiana. **Joe Stanton** is a UNC Greenville wrestling standout and Hall of Fame member. He held the school's wins record of 98–25 for 11 years. He excelled at 158 pounds and has multiple championship appearances and titles. Presently, he serves as Vice President of Thornburg Insurance agency, specializing in commercial insurance and risk management. Joe previously served at the Character Coach and team Chaplain under Coach Escobedo. Joe is married to Shonda, who is the Head Softball Coach at Indiana University.
