An Adventure to Live | Session Five — Video

Overview: As men, we are wired for adventure. These adventures come in three different forms. The *casual* adventure – to fish, ski, or travel. The *crucial* adventure – our calling or mission in life. The *critical* adventure – the deepest of all that involves our intimate partnership with God. The amount of risk with which you are willing to live is a direct correlation to what you believe about God.
