## An Adventure to Live | Session Six — Extended Discussion

## **Extended Discussion Questions:**

- How does the verse above from Psalm 37 speak to you? What images or thoughts come to mind as you read it?
- The book stated that "A man won't be happy until he has adventure in his work, his love and in his spiritual life." Where are you currently finding adventure in each of these areas?
- What makes you come alive? If you were bankrolled for a year to do whatever you wanted without consequence to your current obligations (work, family, church, etc. You would just be free to do your dream), what would you do?
- What adventure have you written off as too big, too late, or too impossible to pursue? How might it change things to realize that God often invites us into adventures we can't do alone ones that are only possible with Him?
- In what ways do you feel a partnership with God? To what degree does that draw you into adventure?
- In the audio, John said that it is important that you wrestle with God. How much of a wrestler are you? (Note: Our May 8<sup>th</sup> Luncheon is titled "We are All Wrestlers")
- How has your sense of adventure changed in the past 5, 10 or 25 years?

Closing Prayer: Jesus, You modeled the ultimate adventure. You came to earth with a definitive purpose that has had eternal implications. Although our purpose is different and most likely will not cost us our life, is it no less eternal in its significance. What we do here matters. Help us to hear your voice and be caught up in the adventure which is specific to each of us. May we go with You into the unknown. Amen.
